## **1. Astonishing variety at Duinrell**

### **1.1 Duinrell — ‘One of Holland's Real Glories’**

Duinrell Holiday and Amusement Park is situated in the green belt of the Randstad, in the dune and woodland area of Wassenaar, close to the beach. The park offers a wide variety of day trip attractions and recreational activities on an estate of over one million square metres. Duinrell is one of the most beautiful and flower-filled parks in the Netherlands thanks to its lush natural beauty. Duinrell host, Rick the Frog, also has a girlfriend called Lelie.

Duinrell offers guests a great holiday or a fun day out in a high quality, tourist holiday resort and amusement park. This ensures preservation of the family estate.

Duinrell offers a range of facilities:

Duinrell receives approximately 1.2 to 1.4 million guests annually (daytrips and overnight stays included).



## 1.2 75-year anniversary of the opening of the Duinrell Estate

It was 75 years ago on 19 April 1935 that the Duinrell Estate was opened to the public by its then owner Philip Count van Zuylen van Nijeveld. For 15 cents people were allowed to take a walk through the spacious woodlands and dunes.

The book *Chronicles of a Family Company* which was specially written for this occasion by the former Wassenaar journalist Luc Dietz, describes the complete history of Duinrell in 160 pages. Moreover, the book is illustrated with 175 pictures about Duinrell. Particularly, the chronicle pays tribute to the life's work of Hugo Count van Zuylen van Nijeveld who at the end of the year 2000 handed over the property management to his sons Philip and Roderick.

Through the years the holiday and amusement park has developed into one of the most beautiful and enjoyable parks in The Netherlands.

In late March 2010, TNT introduced a special Duinrell stamp to honour this anniversary. In April 2010, a tulip at the Keukenhof was christened with the name of Duinrell.

## 1.3 New for the 2011 Season

In order to be able to offer guests an even lovelier holiday experience, a lot of work has once again been carried out recently on further improvements to quality, notably in the holiday park. The past year was one of looking back over Duinrell's 75 year history, but equally of much concentration on investing in the future.

Modernised camping site:

- New layout of the Eiland, which, by popular demand, is no longer a traffic free zone.
- New layout of the Eikenveld, with about 50 more spacious pitches with 10-amp electricity supply.
- Completely new sanitary facilities for the Beukenveld from July 2011.
- Completely renovated main parking area to facilitate improved traffic flow.

## **2. A fun day out at Duinrell, teeming like never before**

### **2.1 Duinrell Amusement park**

Duinrell Amusement Park offers plenty of excitement and relaxation for young and old. This versatile park offers an abundance of spectacular attractions. Examples include the Splash, the Waterspin, the Bumperfrogs, the Aqua Shute, the Aqua Swing and the Rodelbaan (Toboggan run). Also well worth a visit are the Sea Of Balls, a special playground for toddlers, and the large Wonderland playground, the Carousel, Rick's Fun Factory, the theatre shows and Mad Mill. Rick the Frog has his own residence; Rick's Adventure Castle. This castle houses numerous attractions that will delight our youngest guests. In the castle's pond, where Rick the Frog was born, there is a wishing well, the proceeds of which support 'De Opkikker' foundation. Naturally, the list of attractions would be incomplete without the tropical Tiki Pool with all its famous attractions, such as the spectacular Typhoon slide (opened in 2009), and the staggering new X-stream slide (opened in May 2010) that takes you on a sudden vertical fall from the top of the Tiki Pool down into a crystal-clear tube.

### **The longest day out in the Netherlands**

The amusement park will open once again from 16 April until 31 October 2011 inclusive. Duinrell's catchphrase is: 'The longest day out in the Netherlands'. After the amusement park closes (at 17.00 hours daily and 18.00 hours during the holidays and high season), the Tiki Pool stays open until 22.00 hours. The evening opening hours for the restaurants are the same. Rick's Fun Factory, the indoor playground, is open some days in winter. The tropical Tiki Pool is open daily all year round. The restaurants are open in the evenings, too. The tropical Tiki Pool is open all year round.

### **Rollercoaster Falcon**

This is a dazzling roller coaster 380 metres in length with a surface area of 2200 m<sup>2</sup>. Three cars, each carrying eight passengers, drop almost vertically from a height of 22 metres with a speed of 70 km, then travel via a loop and a corkscrew before coming to a standstill. The low-noise attraction is themed and clearly in keeping with the other spectacular attractions.

### **Schools**

Duinrell offers the most comprehensive school outings available. Duinrell has compiled a Day Package for Winter (Tiki Pool and free admission for one supervisor per six students) and a Day Package for Summer, which includes a free 'return admission' ticket to Duinrell for each child and free admission for one supervisor per six children. Duinrell's Duinhostel package is perfect for study weeks. A stay in the Duingalows is also an option.



### **Birthday party**

Duinrell is the ideal location for a special birthday party. Birthday guests can celebrate their party with their friends in the amusement park, the Tiki Pool or indoor playground Rick's Fun Factory, complete with chips and lemonade. One supervisor per six party guests gets free entry.

### **Subscriptions**

This season, subscription holders enjoy unlimited access to Duinrell for an attractive price, as well as additional facilities and offers in and outside the park.

## 2.2 Tropical Tiki pool, a swirling water world

The Tiki Pool offers over one kilometre of indoor slides, which makes it the largest indoor water slide complex in the Benelux. As all Tiki Pool attractions are indoor, it is open in the evenings and all year round. During its last winter maintenance, the Tiki Pool had a complete makeover. Lighting, background music and many new decorative elements were introduced. In the autumn and winter of 2010, the Tiki Pool celebrates its 25th anniversary.

In addition to the pool with wave generator, the toddlers' pool and the mini slides for younger children, the following attractions are to be found in the Tiki Pool:

The Tiki Pool offers over one kilometre of aquatic fun, including:

### **Typhoon**

length: approx. 78 metres  
height: approx. 15 metres  
speed: approx. 50 kilometres per hour

### **Moonlight and Starflight**

length: approx. 150 metres per slide  
height: approx. 16 metres per slide  
speed: approx. 20 kilometres per hour

These two slides feature built-in lighting effects and exciting dark waterfalls – a first in Europe.

### **Blits and Flits**

length: approx. 80 metres per slide  
height: approx. 14 metres per slide  
speed: approx. 60 kilometres per hour  
Two turbo-slides.

### **Family Slide and Superslide**

length: approx. 110 metres per slide  
height: approx. 14 metres per slide  
speed: approx. 20 kilometres per hour  
Two medium slides.



### **Cyclone Space Bowl**

length: approx. 150 metres per slide  
height: approx. 15 metres per slide  
speed: approx. 60 kilometres per hour

A giant funnel, the first in Europe to be fitted with a so-called 'high entry' system. Climb a 15-metre high tower, plunge down the slide at top speed, whirl round inside the funnel and finally splash into a catching pool. The Space Bowl is made of transparent material, so that onlookers can see the silhouettes of spiralling bodies. A catwalk has been built above the Space Bowl for visitors who would rather play safe.

### **Cannon Ball**

length: approx. 6 metres per slide  
height: approx. 2 metres per slide  
speed: approx. 60 kilometres per hour

This slide is short and sweet. From the upper level, you jump into a dark hole to be launched out over the water, where you literally fly through the air for a moment.

### **X-stream**

length: approx. 16 metres  
height: approx 7 metres

Dare devils feel the floor fly out from under their feet at a staggering height of 7 metres, before they fall down into the skim out with a speed up to 40 km per hour. speed: 40 km per hour

### **Pelican Dive**

length: approx. 4 metres per slide  
height: approx. 7 metres per slide  
speed: free fall

A very short and steep turbo-slide.

### **Lazy River**

length: approx. 250 metres per slide  
height: approx. 2.5 metres  
speed: -

The latter is another world first; the first indoor Lazy River. All Tiki Pool attractions in are under cover so they can be used the whole year round. Even when it is snowing, you can bob along the Lazy River over the sun terrace and still stay warm.

### **Hotwhirlpools**

After all the excitement of the water attractions, take it easy in the oval 'Jacuzzi' where the temperature is about 35°C.

### **Scuba diving**

You can earn your diving certificate in one week at Duinrell. Under professional supervision, guests learn the basics of recreational diving in a course that combines theory with practical training. An unforgettable experience!



### 3. An array of holiday ideas at Duinrell

#### 3.1 General information

Duinrell offers many types of overnight accommodation:

- Comfort Basic, Comfort Plus and Comfort Extra Duingalows (for 4, 6 and 7 persons)
- Camping pitches
- Comfort Basis 60 m<sup>2</sup>
- Comfort Basis 100 m<sup>2</sup> (before Comfort XL)
- Comfort Plus 80 m<sup>2</sup> and 100 m<sup>2</sup>
- Comfort Extra 80 m<sup>2</sup> and 100 m<sup>2</sup>
- Comfort Basis with private sanitary 120 m<sup>2</sup>
- Tent and mobile home rentals
- Duinhostel (group accommodation / low budget family accommodation)

From 16 April to 30 October 2011 overnight guests at Duinrell receive a bonus: use of the amusement park. Other facilities include the Tiki Pool, the many dining facilities, the mini golf course, the keep-fit course in the extensive walking area, and the climbing wall.

The tropical Tiki Pool, which opened 26 years ago, is open all winter. In winter, guests can still make use of the tennis courts or take a walk through the walking area within the park. Rick's Fun Factory is open to our youngest guests over weekends.

The holiday resort also serves as a base from which to explore the surroundings either on foot, by bicycle, public transport, or independent transport. In spring, there is the Keukenhof, as well as museums, Madurodam and the Museon in The Hague, Sea Life, the Military Museum in Delft, water excursions through the Groene Hart (Green Belt) of the Netherlands with Rederij Triton, the new Corpus museum in Oegstgeest, or the many museums of Leiden! The Soldaat van Oranje musical is also well worth a visit, in the Hangar Theatre at Valkenburg Airfield. In summer, guests can hire a boat through Sloepy to discover the local surroundings.

#### 3.2 Duingalows



The Duingalows were established in 1991. These are holiday homes, which can be rented in both summer and winter. The Duingalows are fully equipped with all you need for a successful holiday. Duinrell extended the Duingalow Park in 2002 with 100 Duingalows. Duinrell Holiday Resort now has over 417 Duingalows, including an Exclusive Duingalow with double whirlpool and queen-size bed, and a number of new Comfort Extra Duingalows with verandas and additional luxury and space.

The total amount of Duingalows now stands at 417, including a Bridal Duingalow.

- Four-, six- and seven-person Duingalows
- Cosy dining and living room with French windows to the patio
- Fully equipped kitchen
- Shower, toilet and basin
- Bedrooms including duvets and pillows
- Cable TV including most Dutch television channels.
- Patio with garden furniture and umbrella, and a parking space

## **Duingalow Types**

### **Comfort Basis**

Modestly equipped four and six-person Duingalows, offering all facilities. These flat roofed bungalows were the first type to be built at Duinrell. They are situated at the edge of the park. They have a microwave, kettle and toaster. The six-person Duingalows have an extra bedroom with a bunk bed.

### **Comfort Plus**

Comfortably equipped four- and six-person Duingalows near the amusement park, restaurants and supermarket. These Duingalows have two bedrooms, of which one has a double bed. The kitchen is equipped with all the basic conveniences. The bathroom has a shower, hand basin and toilet. Pets are permitted in a number of Comfort Plus Duingalows. The six-person Duingalows have an extra bedroom with a bunk bed.

### **Comfort Extra**

Luxuriously equipped four- six- and seven-person Duingalows with two bedrooms. The luxury kitchen is equipped with all the basic conveniences including a Senseo coffee maker, combi-microwave and dishwasher. The bathroom has a shower and hand basin and there is a separate



toilet. The six-person Duingalows have an extra bedroom with a bunk bed. The toilet is in the bathroom. The seven-person Duingalows have an additional bedroom with an extra bed.

#### **Four- and five-person Comfort Extra with veranda**

Comfortably equipped, beach themed Duingalows with spacious verandas, luxury garden furniture, located at the edge of the park. The four-person Duingalow has two bedrooms; one with a double bed and one with twin beds. The five-person Duingalow has a room with a double bed, and a room with a bunk bed and one single bed. There is a separate toilet and a bathroom with shower and basin. The kitchen has a Senseo coffee maker, combi-microwave and dishwasher.

#### **Baby Duingalows**

There are a number of Baby Duingalows; a four-person Comfort Extra Duingalow with separate baby room.

#### **Exclusive Duingalow**

The Exclusive Duingalow is equipped for two adults with a queen-size bed, double whirlpool and a flat screen TV in the living room and bedroom.

Free entry to the amusement park and Tiki Pool - 16 April to 30 October inclusive

Overnight accommodation in the Duingalows includes free daily entry to the amusement park and two hours free entry to the Tiki Pool between 10:00 and 14:00 hours. Outside the amusement park season, entry to the Tiki Pool is unlimited.

#### **Tour operators**

Duinrell Duingalows can also be booked via Dutch and international tour operators.

They are: RP Holidays and Vrij Uit in the Netherlands; ITS, TUI and Neckermann in Germany, Thomas Cook in Belgium, and Dansk Fri Ferie in Scandinavia.



### **3.3 Camping**

There's plenty of comfortable camping at Duinrell: Approximately 900 camping pitches at different locations in the woods around the amusement park make for a camping experience that is custom-made.

The camping site is open all year round and offers every modern convenience, such as toilet blocks with heated floors, hot and cold running water, and laundry and ironing facilities. Pleasant restaurants in the Duinrell Plaza complex and the La Place 'Schaapskooi' restaurant are all within walking distance. Campers at Duinrell receive free admission to the amusement park from 4 April to 1 November 2009 and receive discounted admission to the Tiki Pool.

You can choose from a variety of camping pitches: Comfort with private sanitary facilities, Comfort Extra, Comfort Plus, Comfort, Comfort XL or Standard.

#### **Comfort deluxe with private sanitary facilities**

These Comfort pitches are situated at the edge of the dune area and offer the same amenities as the Comfort pitches, but they have their own sanitary facilities close to the pitch.

#### **Comfort Extra**

These pitches of roughly 80 m<sup>2</sup> each, can accommodate one tent or caravan, one car and one small tent. Each pitch has water drainage, electricity and a connection for cable television. The deluxe sanitation buildings offer many extras such as extensive laundry and ironing facilities, children's toilets and excellent showers with free hot water. At the "Romantic Camp" you will even find a dishwasher.

#### **Comfort Plus**

The Comfort Plus pitches offer the same facilities as the Comfort Extra with the exception of a hook-up for cable television.

#### **Comfort**

The Comfort pitches at Duinrell are about 70 m<sup>2</sup> and equipped with an electrical hook-up. These pitches accommodate one tent or caravan, one car, and an awning.

#### **Comfort XL**

This season Duinrell is introducing Comfort XL pitches of around 100 m<sup>2</sup>. These pitches offer the same facilities as the comfort pitches, but are much larger.

#### **Standard**

At Duinrell, you can also reserve pitches without electricity or other facilities.



### **Tent hire and mobile home rental**

Fully furnished bungalow tents and mobile homes are also available at the campgrounds. The tents are hired out by Holiday Break (Eurocamp and Keycamp), Canvas, VacancesSelect (Select Camp), Al Fresco, Happy Camp and Koko Holidays. These facilities are being expanded to include fully furnished mobile homes.

### **3.4 Duinhostel**

Groups can book accommodation at Duinrell in the Duinhostel. It was fully renovated in the winter of 2007. Duinrell estate's former Coach House is big enough for groups of up to 104 people. The Duinhostel is located between the trees, close to the spot where Duinrell castle used to stand. An ideal place for groups to stay.

The Duinhostel is practically furnished and has retained its rustic character. It provides ideal group accommodation over two floors. On the ground floor, there are nine six-person rooms, each with a shower and toilet, a shared room with colour television and radio, a kitchen and separate toilets. The upper storey has ten five-person rooms, two separate bathrooms with washbasins, showers and toilets, a shared room with colour television, a radio, and a kitchen. Breakfast, lunch and dinner can also be enjoyed in one of the restaurants.

- The Duinhostel has its own terrace and car park.
- The sanitary block at Duinrell was renovated in winter 2010-2011.
- Overnight accommodation in the Duinhostel includes free admission to the amusement park (open from 16 April to 30 October) and discounted admission to the Tiki Pool. Duinhostel guests can use all Duinrell's facilities.
- There are special rates for schools and groups.

### **3.5 Relocation**

Longer stays in the Duingalows can be accommodated in the case of house moves, building work and suchlike. In such cases, Duinrell offers fully equipped, comfortable Duingalows for longer-term hire. Flexible booking options, the central location and many facilities in and around the park offer all you need for long-term stays. In addition, there are many extras such as free entry to the amusement park (from 16 April to 30 October inclusive), the tropical Tiki Pool in the back garden, on-site restaurants and a supermarket, washing and drying facilities, two tennis courts and a delightful walking route.

### **3.6 Catering**

La Place at Duinrell. Home made; always fresh, prepared with natural ingredients. Well-known V&D restaurant chain La Place operates across Duinrell Holiday and Amusement Park with various catering concepts. La Place guarantees fresh, healthy, natural food, prepared on site with the



purest ingredients; usually organic. Ingredients are purchased in the morning from the market, auction and fishmongers and used the same day in food preparation. This is what La Place calls the market principle. All dishes are home-made, prepared by our cooks themselves. Guests are welcome to watch food being prepared. La Place has several sites across the park:

### **Duinrell Plaza**

This location has undergone a complete make over with two totally new restaurants and fully refreshed conference rooms.

### **La Place Restaurant**

A restaurant concept that employs a market theme with 'display' of fresh products that can be enjoyed in a congenial atmosphere, after à la minute preparation.

### **La Place Toscane**

Here guests enter the world of Toscane. This is an exceptional buffet restaurant that serves authentic pizzas and lasagnes as a speciality. Antipasti dishes and grilled vegetables are also on the menu.

### **La Place Take-away**

Serves grilled chicken and meat dishes to take away, as well as homemade fries, croquettes and other snacks.

### **The Irish Pub**

Serves local and imported drinks in a congenial, relaxed environment.

### **La Place 'De Schaapskooi' Restaurant**

This restaurant, which carries an 'Old Farmers' theme throughout, serves breakfast, lunch and dinner. Meals are prepared naturally, according to the La Place principle; home-made, always fresh and with natural ingredients.

### **Take away Tiki Pool**

Just as in the Tiki Pool, oven-fresh bread and sandwiches are on sale here. Fresh juices, smoothies, shakes, La Place coffee, etc. are also available.

### 3.8 Surroundings

Overnight guests can explore the surroundings of Duinrell, for example the 'Wassenaarse Slag', an expansive North Sea beach just 4 kilometres from the park, as well as the nearby cities of the Hague and Leiden, and the coastal towns of Scheveningen, Noordwijk and Katwijk. All are within easy reach and offer plenty to do during the day or night. Guests can also go horse riding, play squash and golf. Local sights include the Miniature city of Madurodam, the Keukenhof in Lisse, the Naturalis museum in Leiden, the Military museum in Delft, the Museon in The Hague, indoor skiing at SnowWorld Zoetermeer, and cruises with the Triton boating company.



## **4. An abundance of activities at Duinrell**

### **4.1 Green Adventures**

Duinrell offers several exciting sports activities to the corporate market, initiated by Green Adventures. Activities consist of one or multiple day packages, with optional food and beverages included.

#### **Adventure Mountain**

Adventure Mountain is a real challenge for active adventurers. Adventure Mountain is thrilling, challenging and surprising. The course includes a teetering rope bridge circuit with fifteen stations perched six metres high among the treetops; abseiling; archery; a low rope uphill bridge circuit; and new this year, a 100-metre zip wire! This attraction is geared toward residential guests and groups.

#### **Adventure Day**

Adventure Day is a sports survival day suitable for young and old. The setting for this day, supervised in its entirety by qualified trainers, is the extensive woods and dune area at Duinrell. The Adventure Day can be tailored for any group of over 15 people. Options include archery, rope making, abseiling and mini-survival.

#### **Trouble Forest**

Trouble Forest is an adventure full of surprises and pitfalls in the Duinrell woodlands and dunes beyond the theme park. Participants receive a backpack with all the necessary equipment to successfully complete both the course and the thinking, action and team assignments. Trouble Forest really is “survival of the fittest”.

#### **Navigation Journey**

A truly fun and educational challenge for young and old. Armed with a compass, chart a course through Duinrell’s varying natural landscape. Along the way, there are many questions to be answered and tasks to be completed. Creativity and teamwork are sure to achieve the best results.

#### **Laser games**

Laser clay-pigeon shooting and Lasershoot are two new skill programmes that require concentration and an accurate aim. Response is tested in a series of assignments, speed and accuracy are the first requirement.

Many activities can be booked in combination for groups, schools, or as corporate packages with a leisure or teambuilding theme.



## 4.2 Other activities

### **Diving in the Tiki Pool**

Under professional guidance, guests (children aged 10 years and above) can take their first steps in the world of recreational diving. Included are both the theory and practical aspects of this challenging sport. It's an experience that guests will not soon forget.

### **Keep-Fit Course**

In the woods around Duinrell, an extensive keep-fit course has been laid out for athletic types. Work out in the open air with training equipment scattered throughout the dune area.

### **The Duinrell Entertainment team**

There is plenty to do at the amusement park and the Tiki Pool, and the Entertainment team also organises many fun, exciting and sports-orientated activities in the afternoons and evenings. These include (youth) discos, arts and crafts, sports tournaments, bingo evenings, performances / shows, etc. The programme is geared particularly towards the holiday season. The programme is especially geared towards holiday periods. For the youngest guests, Rick's Kids Club has become a fully-fledged phenomenon.

### **Miscellaneous**

There are also two tennis courts. Racquets and balls are available at reception. The woodlands and dunes belonging to the park are perfect for long walks. Bicycles are available for hire to get to know the surrounding countryside, as are carts, children's seats and wheelchairs. There are stables nearby, and you can play golf at the Noordwijk Golf Centre. The new Tespelduyn golf course was recently opened in Noordwijkerhout.

### **Musical**

The Soldaat van Oranje musical is well worth a visit, in the Hangar Theatre at Valkenburg Airfield.

### **Boat Hire**

In summer, guests can hire a boat through Sloeply to discover the local surroundings.



## 5. Conference and Party Centre for functions and events

(Duinrell Plaza)

Central to Duinrell is its conference and party centre across a range of locations. The centre offers an abundance of options for a range of events, from staff parties, product presentations and corporate days out, to family days. Each location can be booked separately. Events, meetings, teambuilding sessions, dinners or parties in conjunction with overnight accommodation can be combined into a perfect programme. From 2009, our new caterer, La Place, will service all corporate functions across all locations.

### 5.1 Dinners, receptions, functions

Duinrell offers a range of options for dinners, receptions and corporate functions. Each conference room has an individual theme. Ranging in capacity from 50 to 1750 persons, there is a suitable venue for every occasion. Events are customised and complete with personal assistance. There is also the option of themed functions, in which all arrangements are taken care of for you. Duinrell is particularly well geared up for family days, staff outings and the like. Combining your visit with the amusement park and Tiki Pool is ideal.

### 5.2 Conferences, trade fairs, presentations

The conference centre consists of five, exceptionally modern, fully equipped conference and meeting rooms. The rooms, which enjoy natural daylight and meet all modern requirements, are suitable for events for 20 to 650 persons in any desired format.

#### **5.4 Other facilities for events**

##### **Schaapskooi**

'De Schaapskooi' restaurant, located in the bustling centre of the Duinrell Amusement park, is a charming place with an 'Old Farmers' theme. With four rooms of varying dimensions, a stage, open areas and four bars, 'De Schaapskooi' is the perfect place for group dinners of up to 300 persons, and receptions or (themed) parties for up to 450 persons.

##### **Tiki Pool**

For a sensational company party, you cannot do better than a festive evening in the Caribbean atmosphere of the tropical Tiki Pool. You'll be welcomed with Hawaiian garlands and a tropical cocktail, after which you can enjoy the Caribbean and Barbecue buffets. Relax in the whirlpools to recover from the hectic events of the day and swing to the beat of fine music until late into the night. The Tiki Pool can accommodate groups of 500 for dinner and a maximum of 1.500 for a tropical party.

##### **Carousel**

The Carousel is a charming spot in the Duinrell Amusement park. The Carousel Hall, with its authentic merry-go-round, is perfect for receptions of up to 150 persons. Barbecues can also be organised here for up to 100 persons.

##### **Summer Theatre**

The Summer Theatre provides the venue for Duinrell's spectacular summer shows. The large stage is suitable for shows, presentations, conferences, exhibitions, etc. and there is room for up to 500 persons. When set up for theatre performances, 300 persons can be accommodated.

##### **Oranjerie**

The Oranjerie used to be the coach house on the Duinrell estate. In the winter of 2001, it was transformed into a banquet hall and has been used as such ever since. The Oranjerie is now an exquisite hall with marble floors and large open windows that convey a great sense of space. The Oranjerie can house a maximum of 150 people for standing receptions.



## 6. Interesting facts

### 6.1 History

The story of the Duinrell estate is also the story of the Dutch dune coast. The elongated sand dunes, or high water lines, were formed by the tides of the sea and the Rhine. The higher and younger dunes were formed to the west later. That was the beginning of what is now one of the most popular recreational and nature regions in Holland.

The Wassenaar beach and dune area, very closely located to the Duinrell site, attracts day-trippers in search of peace and quiet and long walks. What are now called the inner dunes were dunes in Roman times. The present Duinrell is situated on the fourth high-water line formed in about 500 BC; the fifth high-water line is now the first line of dunes that faces the sea. When ancient foundations were excavated, it was ascertained that in the distant past, on the spot where castle Duinrell stood, there had once been a delightful garden and a farmstead close by.

### Water catchment

The beautiful dune landscape in and around Duinrell is an important water catchment area for the Randstad, the industrial west of Holland. However, this same water catchment, started by The Hague in the first half of this century, marked the demise of what was then the Duinrell farm. By 1929, the surrounding meadows had become so dry that the estate lost its agricultural function. Happily, the trees proved to be more drought-resistant, so that the beautiful woods remained intact. The lake next to the castle also continued to receive sufficient water.

Through maternal inheritance, Duinrell castle had a succession of owners with interesting names such as 'De Jonge van Ellemeet', 'Van Boetzelaer' and 'Van Pallandt'.

The history of Duinrell is stated below in chronological order.

- Opening new rollercoaster Falcon.



## **2007**

The Holiday Park numbered 417 Duingalows including a 'Bridal Duingalow' and approximately 900 camping pitches for a stay to suit everyone's needs. Complete renovation of the Duinhostel. Inauguration of the exciting new Typhoon water slide in the Tiki Pool, with its many covered water slides, at the beginning of the Christmas holidays.

## **2006**

After the opening of the Tiki Pool in 1984, the 12 ½ millionth guest was welcomed. Renovation of the infrastructure through repaving and construction of a roundabout for improved traffic circulation. Remodelling of several toilet facilities on the campsite. Development of a special toddler and pre-school playground. Bolstering of the entertainment and recreation team. Co-operation with Prins Pet Foods in the organisation of several events, such as the family musical Prins & Ploes, the Prins Pet Foods characters.

## **2005**

Another spectacular international magic show by world famous illusionist Hans Klok in the Summer Theatre. Upgrading of the park and campsite. Expansion of the Duingalow Park with 2 new seven-person Duingalows. Rick the Frog meets his new girlfriend, Lelie.

## **2004**

Opening of Rick's Adventure Castle with a range of attractions. Partnership with "De Opkikker" foundation. Spectacular international magic show by world famous illusionist Hans Klok in the Summer Theatre. Upgrading of the park and campsite.

## **2003**

Opening of indoor playground Rick's Fun Factory (the former Rembrandt Theatre) and Spectacular Rope Challenge: a trail with high rope bridges. Expansion of the Duingalow Park with 100 Duingalows, of which 25 were seven-person Duingalows. Upgrading of the Promenade Square, the catering section of the Tiki Pool and the photo entrance of the amusement park.

## **2002**

Continued expansion of the new Duingalow Park. Renovations to the park's entrance. Additional refurbishment work to the Promenade square. Renovation of the Sea of Balls and the Kolder Theatre, and all dustbins transformed into frog bins. Redecoration of the interior of the Summer Theatre. In the Rembrandt Theatre, the edutainment show was alternated with two laser shows.

## **2001**

The Summer Theatre and the square in front were stylishly renovated. A new attraction, 'The Mad Mill', was placed between the Splash and the Summer Theatre. Renewal of the Space Bowl in the Tiki Pool. Extension of the Duingalow Park with 45 Duingalows.



## 2000

Renovation of the Tiki Pool tower complex with two firsts in the world of water slides; the Moonlight and the Starflight. The new children's 'Locomotion' attraction was built. The former 3D cinema became the Rembrandt Theatre following the purchase of 'de Nachtwacht', (a copy of the famous painting by Rembrandt van Rijn) by Dutch artist Sis Josip. Further upgrading of the amusement park and overnight accommodation. Transfer of management by Count van Zuylen van Nijevelt to his sons Philip and Roderick, who were appointed statutory directors on 1 January 1999.

## 1999

- Completion of the Kikkertuincomplex Conference and Party Centre. Duinrell joined the Conference
- Society of the Netherlands VNC (Vereniging Nederlandse Congresbelangen). Ski Valley and the tennis courts were upgraded and a new Rick the Frog character was developed.

## 1998

Building work commenced on the Kikkertuincomplex with themed restaurants and a supermarket. Investment in a new 3D cinema, a harbour for rowing boats, the Kolder theatre and climbing wall to entertain guests during their stay. The total investment in 1998 represented approximately 7,3 million euros.

## 1997

The campsite was extended with an additional 194 Comfort pitches. Extension of the Duingalow Park with 65 Duingalows, making for a total of 278 Duingalows. A new campsite reception and head office was built.

## 1996

The number of Duingalows was increased from 119 to 213, providing a total of 1,000 beds. Several Duingalows were specially adapted for families with a baby. The nursery was furnished with a cot, changing table, bath and playpen. Due to its success, the comfort campsite was extended by 200 pitches. There are now 500 numbered pitches with space for camping accommodation and a car. A new attraction, the Waterspin, was opened. This exciting attraction can accommodate 40 people going 'over the top' in a number of ways, all at the same time. The total investment amounted to 6,4 million euros.

## 1995

300 numbered Comfort pitches were added to the campsite, each with a minimum area of 80 m<sup>2</sup>. A luxurious sanitary block was built, offering every modern facility. The supermarket was given a new modern interior. The entrance road to Duinrell was upgraded, facilitating easy access for public transport. Additional beautiful flowerbeds and shrubs were planted. The capacity of the Rodelbaan (Toboggan Run) was increased and a new attraction was added to Funworld; radio-controlled trucks.

## 1994

The tropical Tiki Pool was expanded; an investment of 4,5 million euros. Many new aquatic attractions were added, like the Cannon Ball, a whirlpool, the Lazy River and two enormous Space Bowls.



### **1993**

The Bumperfrogs was opened; teeming, colliding frogs in a jungle of flowers and plants. The Duinhostel was extended from 10 to 19 rooms for groups and/or families, accommodating 5 to 9 persons per room. Toilet facilities were expanded on the campsite and in the attraction park. Five mini 10-pin bowling lanes were built in the completely renovated 'De Schaapskooi' restaurant.

### **1992**

In 1992, a sensational new American attraction was opened; the exciting, saturating Splash. Continuing success led to the construction of Duingalow Park 2. There are now 119 luxury Duingalows in total.

### **1991**

The Duingalow Park was opened on the campsite. 51 luxury, rented Duingalows were built on a separate part of the Duinrell estate. They are fully equipped; with everything from corkscrews to colour televisions.

### **1984 – 1990**

The name 'Duinrell Recreation Centre' was changed to 'Duinrell Amusement park and Camp Site'. Mr. Pieter van Vollenhoven opened the tropical 'Tiki Pool' on 19 April 1984. In the following years, many new attractions were added to the park; the Kikker Achtbaan, the Rodelbaan, the Aqua Swing, the Carousel, the Niagara Super Shute, the Cycle Monorail, computerised theatre performances, the Aqua Shute (a water slide) and 3-D cinema. An investment of 27,2 million euros.

### **After 1962**

Duinrell was developed into a recreation park and campsite by the present owner, Count van Zuylen van Nijeveld.

### **After 1945**

The war damage was repaired. Events were organised and the motor cross competitions were revived until 1950.

### **1940 – 1945**

The dune area became the "Sperrgebiet". The SS took possession of the castle, which eventually fell into ruin. The estate also suffered heavily during the war.

### **1935**

The estate was opened to the public in exchange for a considerable reduction in taxes. Admission cost 10 cents! 'De Schaapskooi' was leased as a restaurant, the 'Oranjerie' was converted into a 'Tea Garden' with a tobacco and alcohol licence. In 1935 and subsequent years, the present owner's father built the first ski slope in Holland (skiing on pine needles). Motor cross competitions were also organised and attracted thousands of visitors.
